and their Chapters, subsidiaries, related entities, respective members, volunteers, heirs, successors, assigns, officers, directors, employees, agents, contractors and subcontractors (collectively, the "Releasees") from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin, and for all loss or damage, and all claims or damages therefor, on account of bodily injury, personal injury, death or property damage of or to the undersigned, his guests, invitee, employees or crew, during the Event or arising out of or in any way in connection with the Event and related activities or while the undersigned is competing, or participating, regardless of whether caused in whole or in part by the negligence of Releasees; (2) AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS Releasees and each of them from and against all claims, actions, causes of action, damages, liabilities, losses and judgments (collectively, the "Claims") of or by all guests, invitee, employees and crew of the undersigned for bodily injury, personal injury, death or property damage which they may suffer or incur during the Event or arising out of or in any way in connection with the Event or related activities, regardless of whether caused in whole or in part by the negligence of Releasees; and (3) ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY for and risk of bodily injury, personal injury, death or property damage of or to himself, his guests, invitees, employees or crew and his boat and equipment due to negligence of Releasees or otherwise during the Event or while participating in the Event or related activities or while in or on the Event premises and the common properties and recreational areas and adjacent docks, piers and boat slips.

# CCA GALVESTON CHAPTER LADIES FISHING TOURNAMENT

## September 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016

\$ 100.00 per Angler (this is an individual participant tournament)

There will be a captains meeting for all participants at Pelican Rest Marina on Friday September 9<sup>th</sup> at 5 pm, with a rules presentation at 6 pm. There will be light bites and a cash bar available.

### TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All anglers must weigh in at Pelican Rest Marina, 7819 Broadway St. Galveston, Texas 77554, 409-744-2618. 11am- 2pm is weigh in.
2. Fishing begin at 6:00am. You may leave from wherever you choose.
3. Each participant must be a member of the CCA and have a valid fishing license during tournament hours. Each participant must have a valid photo ID available at weigh master's request.
4. All participants must read, acknowledge, and sign a disclaimer form releasing CCA from any and all liability arising from the organization, promotion, and staging of this event.
5. All participants must comply and obey all Texas Parks and Wildlife and U.S. Coastguard rules, regulations, and game laws.
6. All participant in the boat must be entered in the Tournament.
7. You may use a Licensed Guide to fish with, but at your own expense. (Guide may not hook or reel in fish).
8. Tournament are live, dead or artificial lures. All fish must be caught by rod & reel in adherence to State Law only during tournament hours.
9. No fish pooling. This tournament is an individual effort competition. Violation will result in disqualification in all or part.
10. Fishing hours are from 6:00am to 2:00pm on September 10, 2016. Must be in line for Weigh-in by 2:00pm at Pelican Rest Marina, 7819 Broadway St. Galveston, Texas.
11. Individuals must choose fish to bring to weigh in table. No additional fish will be weighed.
12. Trout (must be at least 15")- Awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>
13. Redfish (must be at least 20" and not greater than 28")- Awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>
14. Flounder (must be at least 14")- Awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>
15. Heavy Stringer (3)- Trout (only one over 25"), (2)- Reds and (1)- Flounder - Awards 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>
16. In case of a tie, the tie will be broken by earliest weigh in.
17. All decisions of the Tournament Director and the weigh master will be final.
18. Reschedule of the tournament will be the decision of the Tournament Director/Officials. If weather conditions do not permit a safe boating/ fishing day.

#### 📍 Tournament Waters include:

Galveston boundaries: the entire Galveston Bay Complex and the contiguous beach front out 1 nautical mile including GALVESTON JETTIES from San Luis Pass to Rollover Pass including Christmas Bay, Chocolate Bay, Bastrop Bay, West Galveston Bay, East Bay, Inter-coastal Waterway and adjoining lakes within the beach front boundaries. Other waters included are: upper and lower Galveston Bay, Campbell Bay, Trinity Bay, and all adjoining upper bays to the San Jacinto River, Trinity River and marsh included up to I-10. All boats must launch within boundaries and no fishing outside of listed boundaries.
